

\$20 REWARD

For the return of tags and catch information

VA Dept. of Game and Inland Fisheries biologists have tagged muskies to study angler catch rates and annual harvest in the James River. The yellow tags will be located near the fish's dorsal fin. Anglers can remove the tags by firmly pulling the monofilament attachment from the fish's body. The fish can then be released or harvested (if legal size).



Some fish have two tags. Both tags are eligible for the \$20 reward. Anglers must submit each tag with catch information to receive a reward.
